VISIT OF FOREIGN MINISTER MAKHDOOM SHAH MAHMOOD QURESHI TO BRUSSELS (DECEMBER 7-8, 2021)

The Foreign Minister Makhdoom Shah Mahmood Qureshi visited Brussels at the invitation of the Belgian Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister, Sophie Wilmès, from December 7-8, 2021. This was the first bilateral visit at the Foreign Minister level in almost a decade.

Apart from the bilateral meeting with his Belgian counterpart, the Foreign Minister :

- (i) Co-Chaired the 6th round of Pakistan-EU Strategic Dialogue with EU High Representative and Vice President Josep Borell ;
- (ii) Met NATO Secretary General, Mr. Jens Stoltenberg ;
- (iii) Interact with Belgian Parliamentarians and MEPs ; and
- (iv) Addressed the media.



THE 6TH ROUND OF PAKISTAN-EU STRATEGIC DIALOGUE



The Foreign Minister Makhdoom Shah Mehmood Qureshi and the EU Representative Josep Borrell co-chaired the 6th round of Pakistan-EU Strategic Dialogue on December 7.

This was the first in-person session of the Strategic Dialogue since the signing of the SEP by the two sides in June 2019. The last (fifth) session was held in virtual format on November 9, 2020.

Foreign Minister Qureshi and HR/VP Borrell reviewed the entire spectrum of bilateral relations and agreed on comprehensive implementation of SEP in all spheres of cooperation.

The HR/VP and the Foreign Minister reaffirmed their resolve to strengthen and protect human rights as well as fundamental freedoms. Foreign Minister Qureshi raised concerns at the rising trends of Islamophobia, xenophobia and religious intolerance in the world and the need for common resolve to counter them.

HR/VP Borrell and Foreign Minister Qureshi discussed the importance of decisive global action on climate adaptation and building climate resilience, and the importance of developed countries taking the lead in mobilising climate finance, noting the significant role of public and private funds, and technology to facilitate the transition. HR/VP Borrell welcomed Pakistan's pronouncement, prior to the Glasgow conference, of its Nationally Determined Contribution to reaching the common climate objectives.

They also exchanged views on other regional issues and reaffirmed their endeavour to promote peace and prosperity through concerted efforts.

THE FOREIGN MINISTER MET THE BELGIAN DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER AND FOREIGN MINISTER



The Foreign Minister Makhdoom Shah Mahmood Qureshi met the Belgian Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Sophie Wilmès, at Egmont Palace on December 7. This was the first bilateral visit at the Foreign Minister level in almost a decade.

The two leaders reviewed the growing momentum in Pakistan-Belgium bilateral relations and agreed to enhance cooperation in a multitude of domains.

Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Wilmès expressed satisfaction at the positive momentum in bilateral relations. She greatly appreciated Pakistan's facilitation and key role in the evacuation, in particular, its support to the successful conduct of the Belgian Operation Red Kite, which evacuated 1400 persons from Afghanistan, including 201 Belgian nationals. It was the first bilateral visit at the Foreign Minister level in almost a decade.

Foreign Minister Qureshi noted that a peaceful and stable Afghanistan was of crucial importance for Pakistan, the region and beyond. He underscored the importance of the international community's engagement with Afghanistan for stabilizing the situation, reviving the economy and facilitating lasting peace and stability. He stressed that international engagement and support was vital to avert a humanitarian catastrophe, prevent outflow of refugees and stop Afghanistan from once again becoming a terrorist safe haven.

Foreign Minister Qureshi extended an invitation to Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Wilmes to visit Pakistan at mutually convenient dates, which she gladly accepted.

THE FOREIGN MINISTER MET NATO SECRETARY GENERAL



The Foreign Minister Makhdoom Shah Mehmood Qureshi met NATO Secretary General Jens Stoltenberg at the NATO headquarters in Brussels, on December 7.

The two leaders reviewed the status of bilateral cooperation and exchanged views on the regional situation, including the latest developments in Afghanistan.

Recalling his last meeting with the Secretary General in Brussels in June 2019, Foreign Minister Qureshi underscored that the regular high-level political and military engagements between the two sides have contributed towards strengthening bilateral cooperation and partnership.

Secretary General Stoltenberg appreciated Pakistan's invaluable support during the NATO's two-decade long engagement in Afghanistan, including through the Air and Ground Lines of Communications as well as the pivotal role during the evacuation of NATO staff and nationals of NATO member states from Afghanistan.

The Foreign Minister expressed the hope that the international community would expeditiously extend financial and humanitarian assistance to enable the country to meet its compelling needs, help avert a humanitarian catastrophe, stop fresh outflows of migrants, and prevent Afghanistan from once again becoming a safe haven for terrorists.

Both sides agreed to work together for promoting Pakistan-NATO relations and to remain engaged on issues of mutual interest.

While the world is still busy combating the Corona epidemic, India has been already busy currying favour with the international community in Kashmir, also reasserting its special semi-autonomous status and following the disputed region into two states (Jammu and Kashmir) in August 2019. At stake is not just the legal personality but also the demographic character of the constituent state of Jammu and Kashmir and their religious identity of its majority-Muslim people, writes Imtiaz Ahmad.

Jammu and Kashmir is a 300-year-old international dispute. The UN Security Council has passed several resolutions that call for the holding of a free and fair plebiscite to determine the political aspirations of the Kashmiri people. This makes self-determination an inalienable right of the Kashmiris. Therefore, by amending Article 370 of the Constitution, which granted the state of Jammu and Kashmir the special status, and thereby ending and amending it, India has violated its international obligations in the region.

"You may have blinded all of us, every one of us, with your pellet guns by then. But you will still have eyes to see what you have done to us. You're not destroying us. You are constructing us. It's yourselves that you are destroying." - (Arundhati Roy)

The above quote of Arundhati Roy, the veritable conscience of India, shows the odious face of the tragedy unfolding in Indian occupied Kashmir. One of the ethereally beautiful paradises on earth is being ravaged by an occupation force numbering nearly a million strong paramilitary, police and military troops operating under infamous Public Safety and Prevention of Terrorism Acts. The pellet guns that are used to target wild animals are being used on innocent Kashmiris to deny them their rights of self-expression granted under UN Charter. The heartless Indian occupation force has injured 10,500 Kashmiris between 2016 and October 2020, blinding 159 and partially blinding 410, including children and women. The brutal oppression of the population was compounded in the Covid-19 environment where, instead of providing succor to the population, a communications blockade was imposed throughout the Indian-occupied state of Jammu and Kashmir. The digital blackout for the hapless populace continued for over seven months creating a world record of internet apartheid, writes Raashid Wali Janjua.

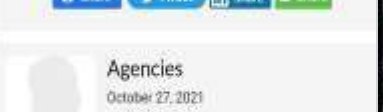

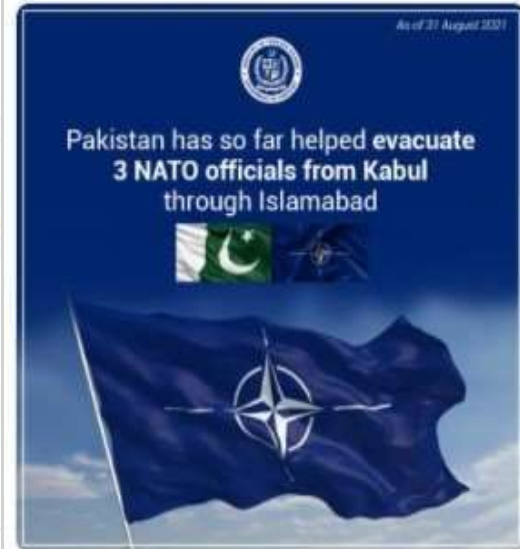

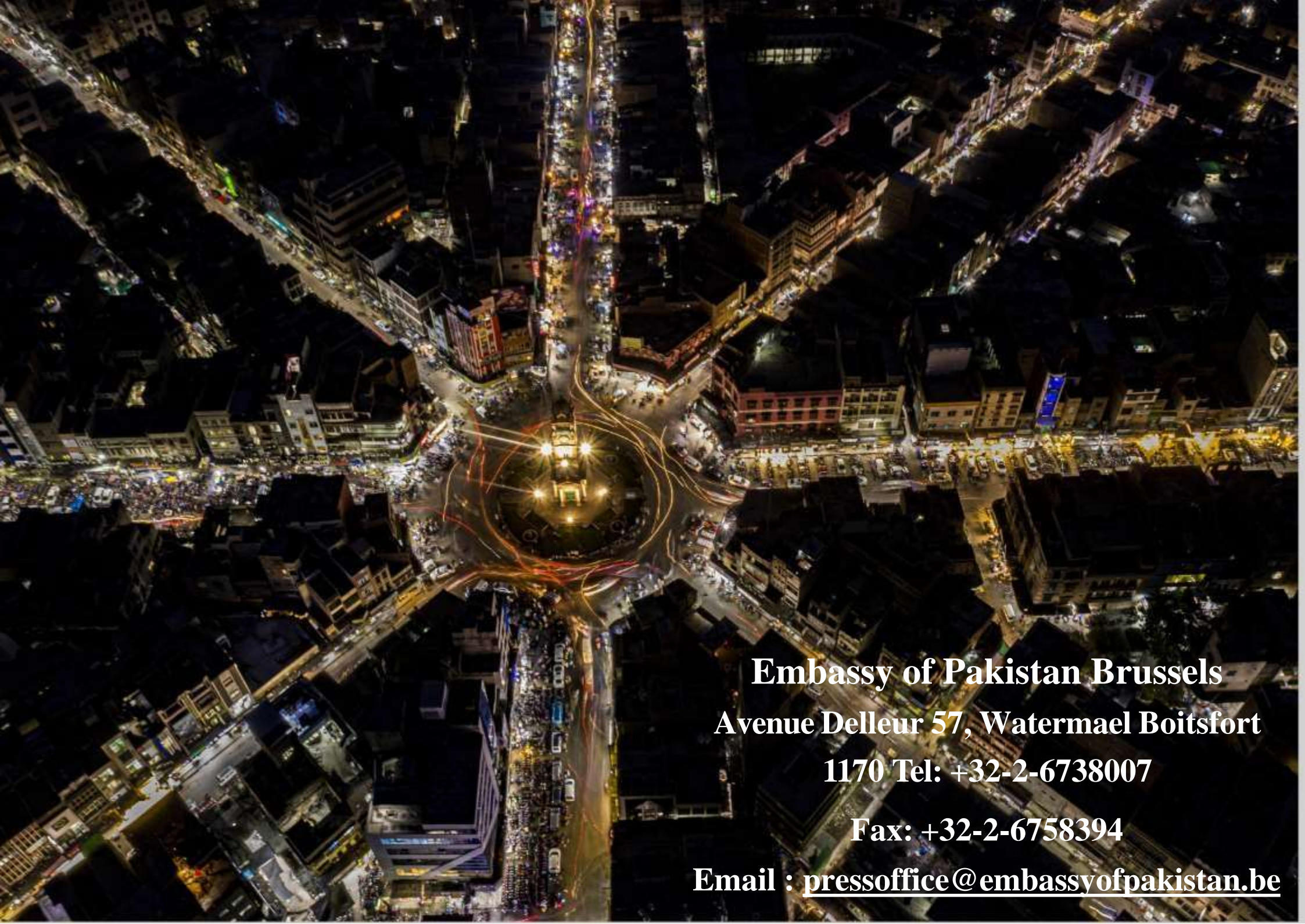
