Ambassador's Message

Dear friends,

I am honored to arrive in Brussels to join as Ambassador of Pakistan to the European Union, Belgium and Luxembourg. I will be presenting my credentials to His Majesty King Philippe later this month.

Prior to my present assignment, I have had the privilege of serving as Pakistan's Ambassador to the USA from 2019-2022 and to Japan from 2017-19.

Pakistan enjoys excellent relations with the EU and all its member states, which are based on mutual understanding, respect and common values of democracy and pluralism. In Brussels, I am determined to work on enhancing ties particularly trade and investment relations between Pakistan, EU, Belgium and Luxembourg.

Overseas Pakistanis based in Belgium and Luxembourg are an important bridge and a key stakeholder in our relations. I would, therefore, work very closely with members of our community to forge a strong and deeper partnership with EU, Belgian and Luxembourg.

Soon after my arrival in Brussels, we have had the privilege of hosting Pakistan's Federal Minister of Commerce and Investment, Syed Naveed Qamar, in Brussels for a two-day official visit on 22 and 23rd of May 2022. The visit was aimed at strengthening the existing commercial and trading relations between the two sides. The Minister held several meetings at the European Institutions, with key Members of the European Parliament (MEPs) and Secretary of State for the Brussels region. He also interacted with the media.

I have also started my outreach to my counterparts in the diplomatic corps, senior EU and Belgian officials as well as members of the European Parliament to present our position and perspective on issues of common interest and concern.

During the past month, we lost a seasoned Pakistani journalist Mr. Khalid Hameed Farooqi, who was the Brussels correspondent of Geo News. Our thoughts and prayers are with the family of Mr. Farooqi.

Over these past weeks, I also had the privilege of interaction with several distinguished members of the Pakistani community from various walks of life. I also had the pleasure of meeting the members of Pakistani media corps based in Belgium. I look forward to working with you all.


