



OVERSEAS PAKISTANIS PLAYING INSTRUMENTAL ROLE IN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF COUNTRY: PRESIDENT

President Dr. Arif Alvi has underscored the need for early initiation of the registration for Overseas Pakistanis to enable their participation in the polling process through i-voting in the next General Elections scheduled in 2023.

Chairing a meeting of sub-committee on Emerging Technologies in I-voting, the President said that Pakistani diaspora members were playing an instrumental role in the economic development of the country and they should be facilitated to cast their vote in line with the orders of the Supreme Court of Pakistan.

President Dr. Arif Alvi said the process of the electoral reforms was the basic mandate and fundamental responsibility of the Election Commission of Pakistan and the Government should provide guidance and technical support to enhance their capacity, as and when requested (June 6, 2021).

PM IMRAN KHAN URGES THE WORLD TO JOIN HANDS IN SAVING ENVIRONMENT FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS



Prime Minister Imran Khan urged the world community to come together and join hands to protect the ecosystem, increase tree-cover and save the environment for coming generations.

"It is time for the world to come together and save the environment for our future generations," PM Imran Khan said while addressing the virtual launch gala of UN Decade on Ecosystem Restoration. Appealing to the world community, the Prime Minister said there was a need for all to protect ecosystem, environment and stop the rapid depletion of tree-cover as well as the degradation of the environment.


Sharing Pakistan's efforts for improving the environment, Prime Minister Khan pointed out that Pakistan, as part of the UN Decade of Ecosystem Restoration, had so far completed the plantation of one billion trees and its target was to plant 10 billion trees.

The Prime Minister added that Pakistan had also started another ambitious program of adding nine national parks to the existing 30 national parks in the country (June 4, 2021).

FOREIGN MINISTER QURESHI MET AMBASSADORS OF THE EU MEMBER STATES

Foreign Minister Makhdoom Shah Mahmood Qureshi hosted the Ambassadors of the EU member states at lunch at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Islamabad.

The Foreign Minister welcomed the Ambassadors and stated that Pakistan greatly valued its relations with the European Union, which are based on shared values and common objectives of peace, prosperity and development. The Pakistan-EU relationship had strengthened steadily over the years and has pursued through sound institutional mechanisms and dialogue processes. The two sides elevated their relationship by signing the Strategic Engagement Plan (SEP) in June 2019. SEP is a forward-looking and comprehensive framework of cooperation in diverse areas of mutual interest.



Foreign Minister Qureshi expressed satisfaction at the trade and investment relations between Pakistan and the European Union. He also appreciated the continuation of GSP Plus status to Pakistan. The Foreign Minister highlighted the positive outlook of Pakistan's economy. He added that the growing economic trajectory coupled with extensive natural resources offered huge opportunities for enhanced trade, investment, and tourism.

The Foreign Minister stressed the importance of economic and cultural diplomacy and called for deeper engagement between Pakistan and the European Union in these spheres.



The Foreign Minister highlighted the grave human rights situation in Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu & Kashmir (IIOJK) and underscored the importance of a peaceful solution of the Jammu & Kashmir dispute in accordance with relevant UN resolutions. He dilated upon Pakistan's positive contributions to the Afghan peace process and facilitative role in advancing the cause of peace, stability and prosperity in Afghanistan, the region and beyond (January 1, 2021).

THE EU REMAINS AN IMPORTANT MARKET FOR PAKISTAN'S TEXTILE SECTOR: AMBASSADOR JANJUA

Ambassador Zaheer A. Janjua, said that the textile sector of Pakistan had immense potential for further expanding its share in the European Union (EU) market. He made these remarks in a virtual meeting with the CEO of Pakistan Textile Council, Ms. Saleha Asif and other board members.

Appreciating the performance of the textile sector during the COVID-19 Pandemic, Ambassador Janjua underscored that Pakistan's textile and apparel exports to EU had increased in recent months.





The Ambassador said that the surge in textile exports was the result of governments' smart lockdown strategy, reopening of industry as well as recently announced energy package to help exporters recuperate from the effects of the pandemic.

He said that the GSP Plus facility had been instrumental in substantial growth of Pakistan's exports to the EU, especially in the textile sector. While emphasizing the need for making the textile sector internationally competitive, he stressed upon the need for innovation, value addition, diversification and modernization to make Pakistan's products more attractive (January 14, 2021).

FIRST ONLINE KHULI KATCHERY WITH PAKISTANI DIASPORA IN BELGIUM AND LUXEMBOURG

he Embassy of Pakistan, Brussels, organized the first online Khuli Katchery with Pakistani diaspora in Belgium and Luxembourg. This interaction was organized in consonance with Prime Minister Imran Khan's directions and Embassy's endeavours to serve the Pakistani community in the best possible manner.

The Khuli Katchery was attended by a large number of Pakistani community members, businessmen, students and media personnel.



Ambassador Zaheer A. Janjua briefed the participants on the efforts being undertaken by the Embassy to extend seamless consular services (January 28, 2021).

KASHMIR SOLIDARITY DAY 2021



In a special video message on the Kashmir Solidarity Day, Ambassador Zaheer A. Janjua urged the international community especially the European Union, to play its role in ensuring fundamental human rights and freedoms of the Kashmiri people.

In his message on the occasion, Ambassador Janjua reaffirmed Pakistan's unflinching support to the brave and resilient Kashmiri people in their struggle for freedom from illegal Indian occupation.

He said that the Kashmiri people had rendered unmatched sacrifices for their legitimate right to selfdetermination over the course of more than seven decades.

Referring to the Indian illegal and unilateral actions of 5 August 2019, Ambassador Janjua said that India has changed the special status of the IIOJK and introduced a series of new domicile regulations to perpetuate its illegal occupation and to change its demographic structure in contravention to the UN resolutions.

Ambassador Janjua highlighted that tens of thousands of innocent people had been arbitrarily detained and thousands of young boys

abducted and incarcerated at undisclosed locations. This was a true manifestation of Indian state-terrorism against the Kashmiris.

He called for the immediate lifting of the military siege and communications blackout, rescinding India's illegal and unilateral actions, release of illegally arrested and incarcerated Kashmiris, repeal of the draconian laws enabling impunity to Indian occupation forces and access of the international human rights organizations and media, to evaluate the human rights situation in the occupied territory.

The Ambassador reiterated Pakistan's continued moral, political and diplomatic support to the Kashmiri people for the realization of their legitimate right of self-determination as guaranteed by the UN Security Council resolutions (February 5, 2021).

SECOND VIRTUAL KHULI KATCHERY WITH PAKISTANI COMMUNITY IN BELGIUM AND LUXEMBOURG

Ambassador Zaheer A. Janjua held the 2nd monthly Khuli Katchery in virtual format with Pakistani diaspora in Belgium and Luxembourg.

The event was organized by the Embassy of Pakistan, Brussels, in line with the vision of Prime Minister Imran Khan, to maintain close engagement with Pakistani diaspora and provide seamless service delivery.

In his remarks, Ambassador Janjua underscored that the issues raised and suggestions made by the diaspora during the first virtual interaction had already been addressed.

Appreciating the community for record remittances, he urged them to benefit from the Roshan Digital Account facility for transfer of funds to Pakistan.





He informed that an online session on Roshan Digital Accounts would be organized by the Embassy in collaboration with the State Bank of Pakistan and Habib Bank Limited, on March 6, 2021. He encouraged the community to participate in the event.

He briefed the participants on government's recent initiative to simplify the procedure for issuance of succession certificate.

Ambassador Janjua explained that the legal heirs of deceased Pakistanis can now obtain succession certificates through a quick five stage process facilitated by NADRA (February 26, 2021).

WEBINAR ON "ROSHAN DIGITAL ACCOUNT"

The Embassy of Pakistan, Brussels, in collaboration with Habib Bank Limited (HBL) and the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP), organized a webinar on "Roshan Digital Account" (RDA) on 6 March 2021.

The webinar, titled "Bridging Distances" was organized to raise awareness among the Pakistani diaspora in Belgium and Luxembourg about the features and advantages of the RDA scheme. The webinar was addressed by Ambassador Zaheer A. Janjua, HBL Chief Operating Officer Mr. Sagheer Mufti and SBP Managing Director Syed Irfan Ali.

Speaking on the occasion, Ambassador Janjua termed RDA a timely initiative of the Government, which would integrate the diaspora into Pakistani banking and digital payments system by providing them a full range of banking services. He noted that this initiative had seen remittances of more than US\$ 500 million through opening of 93,000 accounts worldwide in the first 5 months since the inception of the Scheme.



The Ambassador highlighted that during the first seven months of the current financial year (2020-21), remittances from Belgium and Luxembourg had increased by 305 percent to US\$ 136.4 million. He underscored that this was the highest percentage increase and



highest per capita remittances among the EU countries. The Ambassador thanked the diaspora for the record increase in flow of remittances and hoped that this trend would continue in the future.

The Chief Operating Officer HBL Mr. Sagheer Mufti, spoke on RDA's wide range of benefits for the investors. The Managing Director SBP, Syed Irfan Ali also made a detailed presentation on key features of RDA.

The virtual interaction was attended by a broad cross section of Pakistani diaspora based in Belgium and Luxemburg, including bankers, financial experts, business-persons, students, academia, and media. The participants actively participated in the discussion, asked questions about the scheme and appreciated the initiative.

NATIONAL DAY OF PAKISTAN OBSERVED AT THE EMBASSY OF PAKISTAN, BRUSSELS

A flag hoisting ceremony was held at the Embassy of Pakistan, Brussels, to celebrate the Pakistan Day. Ambassador Zaheer A. Janjua, hoisted the national flag at the Chancery building.

The messages of President Dr. Arif Alvi and Prime Minister Imran Khan were read out on the occasion. The President and Prime Minister of Pakistan in their respective messages congratulated the nation and paid tributes to the dynamic and visionary leadership of Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah and Allama Muhammad Iqbal. They reaffirmed their commitment to make tireless efforts to realize the vision of the founding fathers to make Pakistan a social welfare state on the model of Riyasat-e-Madina. hammad Iqbal and ideals of Quaid-e-Azam Mohammad Ali Jinnah, who envisaged Pakistan to be a progressive, moderate and democratic country.

Appreciating the important role of overseas Pakistanis in the development of Pakistan, Ambassador Janjua highlighted the steps taken by the government to address their issues. He encouraged the Pakistani diaspora in Belgium and Luxembourg to continue to play their role in the development and prosperity of Pakistan.

He emphasized that Pakistan stands firmly with its Kashmiri brethren in their just struggle against illegal occupation by India.

In line with the host government's COVID-19 Pandemic related guidelines, the ceremony was restricted and attended by the Embassy officials (March 23, 2021).

ECONOMIC DIPLOMACY IS KEY TO CONSOLIDATE PAKISTAN'S ECONOMIC OUTREACH WITH EUROPE

Ambassador Zaheer A. Janjua, held a virtual meeting with CEO of Pakistan Textile Council, Ms Saleha Asif, on April 7, 2021. The meeting focused on enhancing Pak-EU trading ties.

Underscoring the importance of increasing Pakistan's economic outreach with Europe, Ambassador Janjua stated that Economic Diplomacy was the key to consolidate and expand Pakistan's economic outreach in Europe.

He noted that the GSP Plus Scheme had played a vital role in enhancing bilateral trade between Pakistan and the EU. Ambassador Janjua highlighted that GSP Plus has been mutually beneficial for Pakistan and the EU. Pakistan's exports to the EU had witnessed a growth of 65 percent and the EU's exports to Pakistan had increased by 44 percent since inception of the GSP Plus in 2014.

Commenting on the potential opportunities created by the preferential market access, Ambassador Janjua emphasized on diversification and value addition of Pakistani exports to the EU. He assured close cooperation and support to Pakistani exporters.

Ms. Saleha Asif appreciated the efforts of the Embassy in promoting trading relations between Pakistan and Europe.




FOURTH VIRTUAL KHULI KATCHERY WITH PAKISTANI COMMUNITY IN BELGIUM AND LUXEMBOURG

Ambassador Zaheer A. Janjua held the 4th monthly Khuli Katchery in virtual format with Pakistani diaspora in Belgium and Luxembourg on 30 April 2021.

Ambassador Janjua informed the participants that the Embassy would remain closely engaged with the community and continue to extend all possible services and assistance. In this regard, the Ambassador had assigned dedicated staff to facilitate the applicants with documentation and submission of forms.





Appreciating the contributions of the Pakistani diaspora, the Ambassador highlighted that remittances from Belgium had reached US \$ 176.9 million, witnessing an unprecedented increase of 275 percent year on year basis.

During the interaction, the diaspora members conveyed their suggestions regarding visas, NICOPs and passports. The Ambassador welcomed the input of the community and assured that their suggestions would be implemented.

The community members appreciated the Embassy's outreach efforts and provision of efficient consular services.

FOREIGN MINISTER ADDRESSES THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT'S FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE (AFET)

Foreign Minister Makhdoom Shah Mahmood Qureshi addressed the Foreign Affairs Committee (AFET) of the European Parliament (EP) at the invitation of its Chair MEP David McAllister. The Foreign Minister was joined by Ms. Zartaj Gul, Minister of State for Climate Change; Mr. Mian Farrukh Habib, Minister of State for Information and Broadcasting; Malik Ehsan Ullah Tiwana, Chairman National Assembly Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs; Ms. Andleeb Abbas, Parliamentary Secretary for Foreign Affairs; Ms. Maleeka Bokhari, Parliamentary Secretary for Law and Justice; Mr. Lal Chand Malhi, Parliamentary Secretary for Human Rights; Foreign Secretary and senior officials of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The Foreign Minister's address was followed by an exchange of views with the Members of European Parliament (MEPs) belonging to different political groups.

In his remarks, Foreign Minister Qureshi dilated upon various aspects of Pakistan-EU relations and regional and international developments. He stated that the Pakistan-EU Strategic Engagement Plan (SEP) had ushered in a new phase in the partnership by providing a solid foundation and framework for multidimensional coop-







eration between the two sides. Highlighting the enormous potential in further expanding Pakistan-EU ties in diverse spheres, he conveyed Pakistan's readiness to continue to work for a productive and constructive partnership.

Underscoring the importance of trade and economic cooperation, Foreign Minister Qureshi underscored that the EU's GSP Plus facility to Pakistan had been mutually beneficial and played an important role in growth of trade between the two sides. He reaffirmed Pakistan's commitment towards effective implementation of GSP Plus related international conventions. He also appreciated EU's support to Pakistan in the fight against COVID-19 Pandemic.

Expressing disappointment at the adoption of a resolution by the European Parliament on blasphemy laws in Pakistan, Foreign Minister Qureshi emphasised the importance of understanding the special feelings and reverence Muslims have for the personality of the Holy Prophet (PBUH). Freedom of expression could not be used to hurt religious feelings of others and willful provocation and incitement to hatred and violence must be universally outlawed. The Foreign Minister stressed that xenophobia and Islamophobia were on the rise and Pakistan and the EU should work together for peaceful coexistence, and interfaith and cultural harmony.

Foreign Minister Qureshi underscored that peace and stability in Afghanistan are paramount for realizing Pakistan's vision of regional economic integration. Pakistan wishes to see an end to the Afghan conflict through an Afghan-led and Afghan-owned negotiated political settlement. Pakistan has played and continues to play a key role in facilitating the Afghan peace process. Foreign Minister Qureshi maintained that the Jammu and Kashmir dispute remains the single biggest obstacle in the way of building durable and lasting peace in South Asia.

The Chair of AFET, MEP David McAllister, in his remarks highlighted the importance of Pakistan-EU relations and the Parliament's interest in further strengthening this partnership. He thanked the Foreign Minister for his detailed exchange of views with AFET Committee. Members of the AFET Committee and heads of delegations for relations with third countries and regions participated in the session (May 26, 2021).


The event was organized in line with the vision of Prime Minister Imran Khan, to maintain close engagement with the Pakistani diaspora and to provide seamless services.

The Embassy of Pakistan, Brussels in collaboration with the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) and Meezan Bank Limited, organized a webinar on "Roshan Digital Account" (RDA) Sharia compliant investment and financing opportunities.

The webinar was addressed by the Ambassador Zaheer A. Janjua, founding President and CEO Meezan Bank, Mr. Irfan Siddiqui, and SBP Managing Director Syed Irfan Ali.


Speaking on the occasion, Ambassador Janjua termed RDA as an innovative initiative of the Government, which has facilitated Pakistani diaspora in sending money to their loved ones in Pakistan and eased digital payment system by providing full range of banking services. He noted that during the first 10 months of the current financial year 2020-21 (July-April), remittances



from Belgium and Luxembourg have increased by 270 percent amounting to the US \$202.6 million as compared to the US \$54.8 million in the corresponding period of the previous financial year.

The Ambassador thanked the diaspora for the record increase in the flow of remittances and hoped that this trend would continue in the future. The Ambassador underscored that the trend was a sign of confidence and trust of the overseas Pakistanis in the economic policies of the government.

The founding President and CEO of Meezan Bank, Mr. Irfan Siddiqui, spoke about the wide range of benefits for the subscribers un-

Pakistan-EU Joint Commission

The Pakistan-European Union Joint Commission was held by video conference.

The plenary of the Joint Commission was preceded by sub-group meetings on Development Cooperation (25 February 2021); Trade (2 March 2021); and Democracy, Governance, Rule of Law and Human Rights (1 June 2021).

The Joint Commission provided an opportunity to exchange views on all areas of cooperation between the EU and Pakistan.

Pakistan underlined that the EU is a valued partner of Pakistan, being home to a large Pakistani diaspora, its biggest trading partner and a source for investment, remittances and economic assistance.















The EU and Pakistan reiterated their commitment for the full and effective implementation of the EU-Pakistan Strategic Engagement Plan (SEP), signed in June 2019.

The Joint Commission was co-chaired by Mr. Noor Ahmed, Secretary of Economic Affairs Division (EAD), and Mr. Gunnar Wiegand, Managing Director for Asia and the Pacific in the European External Action Service ZXC (EEAS).

Representatives of relevant Ministries of Government of Pakistan as well as from the European Commission, the Ambassador of the EU to Pakistan, Pakistan's Ambassador to the EU and observers from EU Member States also participated in the meeting.

It was agreed to hold the next session of the Joint Commission in Islamabad in 2022 (June 16, 2021).

Foreign Minister's meeting with EU High Representative/Vice President

The Foreign Minister, Makhdoom Shah Mahmood Qureshi, and the European Union High Representative for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy/Vice President (HR/VP) of the European Commission Mr. Josep Borrell met on the side-lines of the Antalya Diplomacy Forum in Turkey on June 18. The two leaders discussed the entire spectrum of Pakistan-EU relations as well as global and regional situation, including the Afghan peace process and Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir (IIOJK).

The Foreign Minister underscored that Pakistan-EU relations had further strengthened with the implementation of the Strategic Engagement Plan (SEP), signed in June 2019. He maintained that the SEP had ushered in a new era in bilateral ties and provided a solid architecture for multi-dimensional cooperation.

Emphasizing the importance of bilateral trade, the Foreign Minister highlighted that GSP Plus had been a mutually beneficial undertaking and played an important role in the growth of trade between the two sides. He reiterated Pakistan's firm commitment towards the GSP Plus preferential trade regime and effective implementation of the twenty-seven related international conventions. The two leaders also exchanged views on the Covid-19 Pandemic. Appreciating the EU's support, the Foreign Minister delineated the steps taken by Pakistan to effectively tackle the situation. The Foreign Minister also briefed on Pakistan's progress towards the comprehensive implementation of the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) Action Plan and sought the EU's support in the review process. The Foreign Minister emphasized that at a time of rising Islamophobia, racism and populism, the international community must show a common resolve against xenophobia, intolerance and incitement to violence on the basis of religion or belief.

In the regional context, the Foreign Minister briefed on Pakistan's vital contributions to the Afghan peace process and stressed that the conflict could only be settled through an Afghan-led and Afghan-owned political process. Both sides urged all Afghan factions to seize the historic opportunity presented by the current peace process to settle the conflict through political means. The Foreign Minister emphasized the need for continued engagement of the international community after withdrawal of foreign forces from Afghanistan. The two sides agreed to cooperate in facilitating the peace process, resettlement of Afghan refugees, preserving the socio-political gains of the past two decades and supporting Afghanistan post-withdrawal.

The Foreign Minister also briefed the HR/VP on the continued precarious human rights and security situation in IIOJ&K and the latest moves by the Indian government to perpetuate its illegal occupation. He urged the EU side to take note of the systemic and gross human rights violations in IIOJ&K and play its role for resolution of the dispute in accordance with the UNSC resolutions and the aspirations of the people of Jammu and Kashmir. EU HR/VP Borrell shared his concern on the prevailing situation in the IIOJ&K. The two leaders agreed to continue to maintain high level engagement to further strengthen Pakistan-EU relations. EU HR/VP Borrell extended an invitation to the Prime Minister of Pakistan for a working visit to Brussels. The Foreign Minister reiterated invitation to the High Representative to visit Pakistan (June 18, 2021).

SIXTH VIRTUAL KHULI KATCHERY WITH PAKISTANI COMMUNITY IN BELGIUM AND LUXEMBOURG

Ambassador Zaheer A. Janjua, held the 6th monthly Khuli Katchery in a virtual format with Pakistani diaspora in Belgium and Luxembourg.


Speaking on the occasion, Ambassador Janjua underscored that Khuli Katchery sessions have provided a forum for direct interaction between the Embassy and Pakistani community which has contributed towards improved service delivery. He emphasized that the Embassy will continue to remain closely engaged with the community to extend the best possible services by incorporating their inputs.

Ambassador Janjua emphasized that despite economic decline around the world, Pakistan's economic growth is reflective of Government's sound economic recovery policies.

Highlighting Government's measures for accelerating the post-pandemic recovery, he referred to allocation of Rs. 20 billion for the health sector, special package given to the construction industry, issuance of Eurobonds and spurring industrial growth by 3.57 percent, manufacturing by 8.77 percent, construction by 8.34 percent and services by 4.43 percent.



The Ambassador underlined that Pakistan Stock Exchange has been named as the best Asian Stock Market and the fourth-best Stock Market in the world. He stressed that as a result of all these measures, Pakistan recorded growth of 3.94 percent, which is almost twice the expected rate. The Ambassador also highlighted the success of Roshan Digital Account and Embassy's efforts to promote it.



Appreciating Pakistani diaspora, the Ambassador highlighted that remittances from Pakistanis abroad have reached 29 billion, out of which \$ 226 million have been sent from Belgium to Pakistan, witnessing an unprecedented increase of 246 percent, year on year basis.

The event was organized in line with the vision of Prime Minister Imran Khan to maintain close engagement with the Pakistani diaspora and to provide seamless services. The virtual interaction was attended by a large number of diaspora members from different walks of life, including students, business, social services, and media.

The community members appreciated the Embassy's outreach efforts and provision of efficient consular services (June 29, 2021).






