



EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF PRO-WOMEN LAWS A MUST FOR RIGHTS PROTECTION AND INCLUSIVE SOCIETY




Underscoring the significance of women empowerment, President Dr. Arif Alvi emphasized that effective implementation of pro-women laws would be vital for inclusive society. Addressing the Brainstorming Session on Gender-Based Discrimination and Promotion of Legal, Economic and Social Empowerment of Women at Aiwan-e-Sadr on December 23, 2020, the President underlined that his office had been actively engaged for promoting equal rights for women and disabled people.

The President said that as ordained by the Holy Quran and emphasized by the Holy Prophet Muhammad (Peace be Upon Him), women's rights were enshrined in the country's constitution. The President expressed the hope that the session would provide guidance in devising policies on women empowerment.

Expressing concerns over issues faced by women, including domestic violence, insecurity at police stations, delayed disposal of divorce cases, reluctance to register harassment and rape cases, the President said that such sessions were instrumental in raising awareness about these issues. He highlighted government's policies to empower women, including an exclusive loan scheme, to run small and medium enterprises.

The event featured discussions on property rights, inheritance, access to education, health, economic empowerment and gender based discrimination. Experts from legal fraternity, media and other sectors presented their recommendations for strengthening women's rights.

INDUSTRIALIZATION IS THE ONLY METHOD TO ALLEVIATE POVERTY AND ACHIEVE INCLUSIVE ECONOMIC GROWTH



Prime Minister Imran Khan highlighted the importance of industrialization which would help in poverty alleviation efforts of the government, while addressing the business community at the inauguration of AirSial, on December 9, 2020.

The Prime Minister said that industrialization would attract foreign investment and help in the development of Gilgit-Baltistan, former tribal areas and South Punjab. Appreciating China for steering 700 million people out of poverty through industrialization, the Prime Minister said that the China Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) would serve as a transit hub for trade and connectivity leading to inclusive and equal growth.

The Prime Minister congratulated the business community for the new airline, which would create competition in the domestic air industry and bring efficiency in services. Terming Sialkot's business community as "most vibrant", the Prime Minister assured to facilitate them by addressing issues related to Federal Board of Revenue, State Bank and utility companies.

The Prime Minister also announced that a university would be setup at Sialkot to train youth in engineering, technology and artificial intelligence.

FIFTH ROUND OF PAKISTAN-EUROPEAN UNION STRATEGIC DIALOGUE

Foreign Minister Makhdoom Shah Mehmood Qureshi and High Representative/ Vice President Josep Borrell held the fifth round of Pakistan-EU Strategic Dialogue (virtually) on November 3, 2020.

The two sides agreed to make further efforts for the comprehensive implementation of the Strategic Engagement Plan, signed in June 2019, by strengthening the existing and new institutional mechanisms.

The two sides also issued a Joint Declaration on Afghanistan, which reaffirmed strong support for an Afghan-led and Afghan-owned peace process and welcomed the progress made in the last two years, including the agreement between the US and Taliban.





SIXTH ROUND OF PAKISTAN-EUROPEAN UNION POLITICAL DIALOGUE

The 6th round of Pakistan-European Union Political Dialogue was held (in virtual format) on 6 October 2020. Foreign Secretary Ambassador Sohail Mahmood and Deputy Secretary General of European External Action Service Enrique Mora (EEAS) led their respective sides.

The Dialogue covered a broad-ranging agenda, including discussions on Pakistan-EU bilateral relations and exchange of views on regional and international issues.

The Foreign Secretary noted the special significance of this round of Political Dialogue, being the first since the signing of the Pakistan-EU Strategic Engagement Plan (SEP) in June 2019.



GSP PLUS CONTINUES TO BE MUTUALLY BENEFICIAL FOR PAKISTAN AND EU

Ambassador Zaheer A. Janjua highlighted that GSP Plus continues to be mutually beneficial for Pakistan and the EU. He was participating in the GSP stakeholders' Forum, held at the European Commission in Brussels, on September 29, 2020.

He said that Pakistan's exports to the EU had risen by 65% whereas EU's exports to Pakistan had gone up by 47% since inception of the GSP Plus in 2014.

He emphasised that Pakistan remained committed in fulfilling its obligations under the GSP Plus and has been demonstrating consistent progress in the implementation of the 27 international conventions, duly recorded during each review cycle of the scheme. The event was attended by MEPs, Ambassadors and senior officials of the European Commission.



PAKISTAN IS THE TOP INVESTMENT FRIENDLY DESTINATION IN THE REGION: AMBASSADOR JANJUA



Ambassador Janjua interacted with the Chair of the European Parliament's Delegation for Relations with South Asia, MEP Nicola Procaccini, on December 10 2020.

The Ambassador briefed MEP Procaccini on the existing collaboration between the two sides, especially in trade, investment, education, science & technology, people-to-people contacts, human rights and development cooperation.

They agreed to further strengthen bilateral cooperation between the two sides in diverse fields through collaborative engagements.

MESSAGE ON THE KING'S DAY



Ambassador Zaheer A. Janjua conveyed felicitations to His Majesty King Philippe and the people of Belgium in a special message on the "Kings day" on November 15, 2020.

Ambassador Janjua also highlighted friendly and cordial relations between Pakistan and Belgium based on shared values, trust and mutual respect. He said that the relations between the people of the two countries were historic, as Pakistanis fought for the defence of Belgium in World War I.

He particularly mentioned Subedar Khudad Khan, who was awarded a Victoria Cross for his gallantry and heroic actions on the frontlines in Ypres.

The Ambassador also emphasised the importance of making joint efforts for strengthening bilateral relations for mutual benefit of the peoples of the two countries.

VISIT TO THE BRUSSELS HEADQUARTERS OF SOURCING SOLUTIONS PAKISTAN





TaxPak has invested in Pakistan's textile sector with three units producing apparel in Lahore. The company employs a workforce of 2300 Pakistani, out of which 87 percent are women.

PAK ENVOY'S INTERACTIVE SESSION WITH YOUNG PAKISTANI ENTREPRENEURS



INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY SHOULD PLAY ITS ROLE IN IMMEDIATE LIFTING OF INDIAN SIEGE OF HOJK

In a special message on the 1st Anniversary of India's military siege of the Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir, the Ambassador of Pakistan to Belgium, Luxembourg and European Union, Zaheer A. Janjua, issued a special video message.

The Ambassador noted that it had been one year since the Indian government changed the special status of the Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir in complete disregard and violation of international law and the UN Security Council Resolutions.

Ambassador Janjua highlighted the Indian government's additional steps to consolidate its illegal occupation by introducing a series of new domicile regulations to change the demographic structure of the illegally occupied territory.

He emphasized that the current Indian leadership was bent upon perpetuating its illegal occupation by brutally crushing the quest of the Kashmiri people for their fundamental rights, especially the right to self-determination, enshrined in the relevant UN Security Council Resolutions.

The Ambassador said that by taking advantage of the world community's preoccupation with the COVID-19 pandemic, Indian forces further intensified their inhumane crackdown and military siege.



INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATED AT EMBASSY OF PAKISTAN

The Independence Day of Pakistan was observed with patriotic zeal and spirit at Pakistan Embassy, Brussels, on August 14, 2020.

The national flag was hoisted by Ambassador Zaheer A. Janjua during the ceremony.

Keeping in view the COVID 19 pandemic, all necessary SOPs were observed in the graceful ceremony at the Chancery with participation of the Embassy officials.




GLOBAL PRESS EVENT ON CLIMATE ACTION




